Engage and exercise your creativity with a special activity our students warm up with in our Media Arts studio.

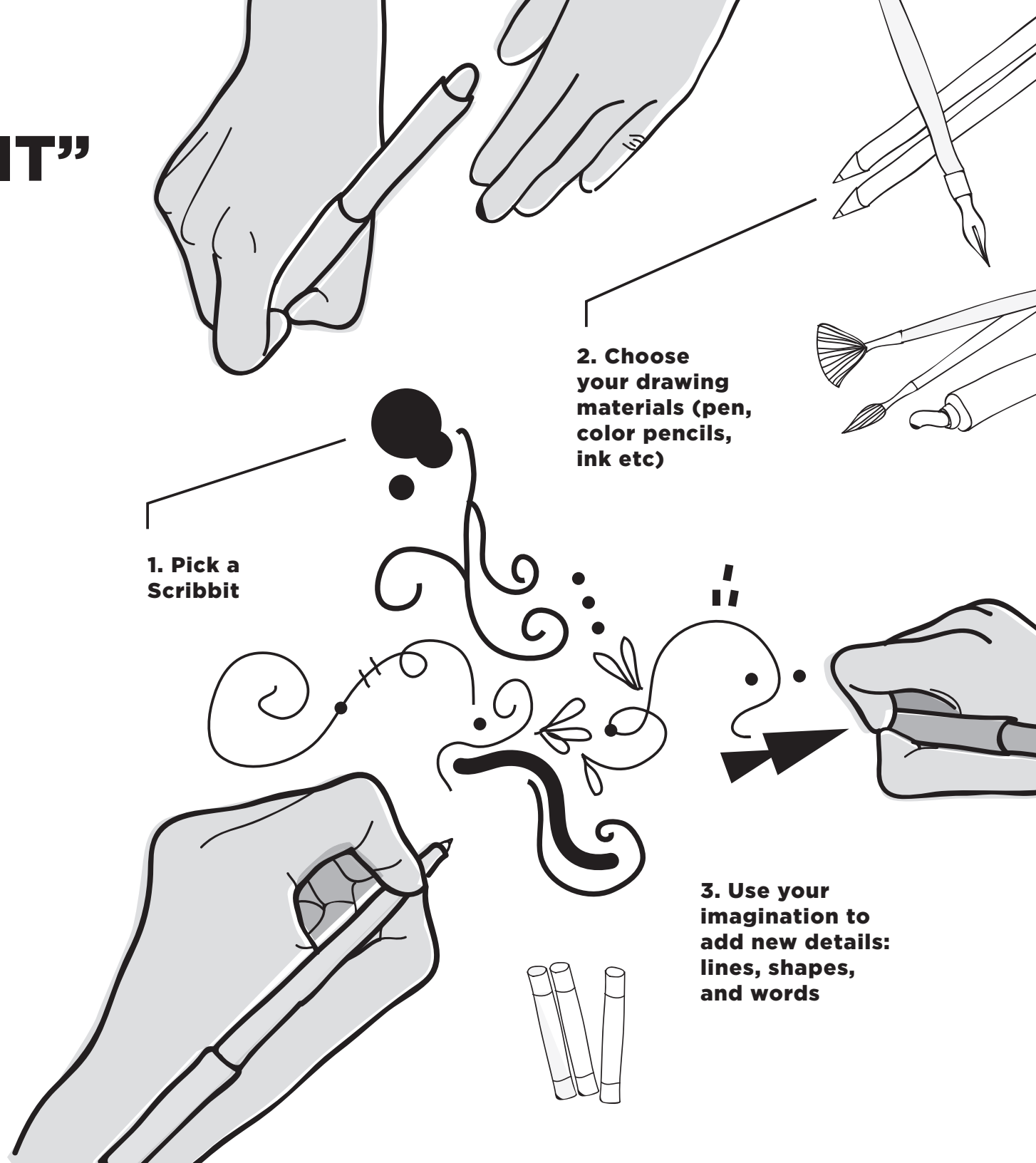
In this book, you will find different starting points we call “Scribbits”. Let the shape of each Scribbit give you clues of what it wants to become.

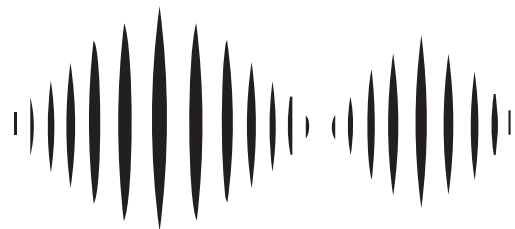
Use your imagination to add new details, colors, and words to transform these Scribbits into something new!

1. Pick a Scribbit

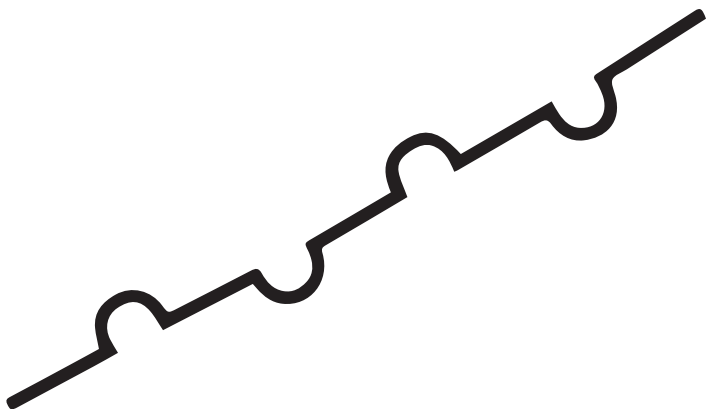
2. Choose your drawing materials (pen, color pencils, ink etc)

3. Use your imagination to add new details: lines, shapes, and words



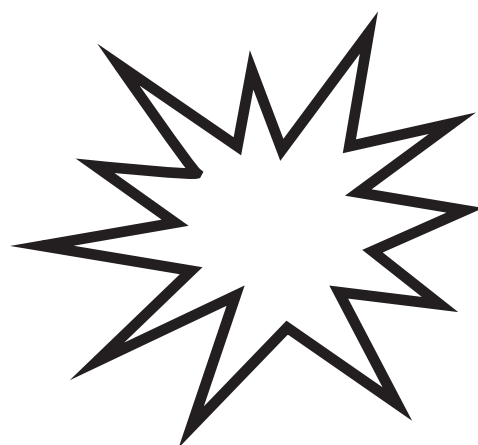


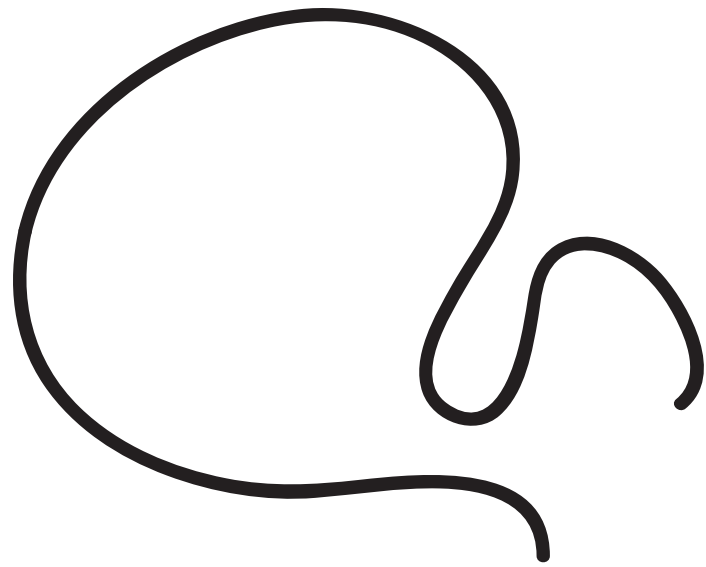


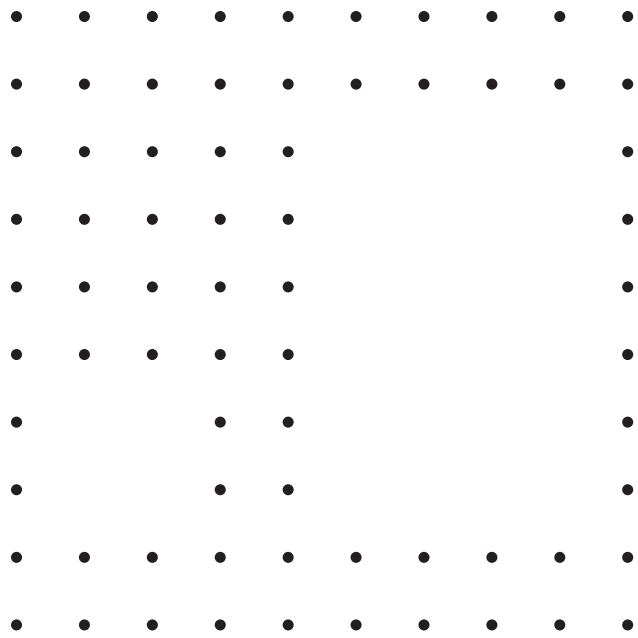


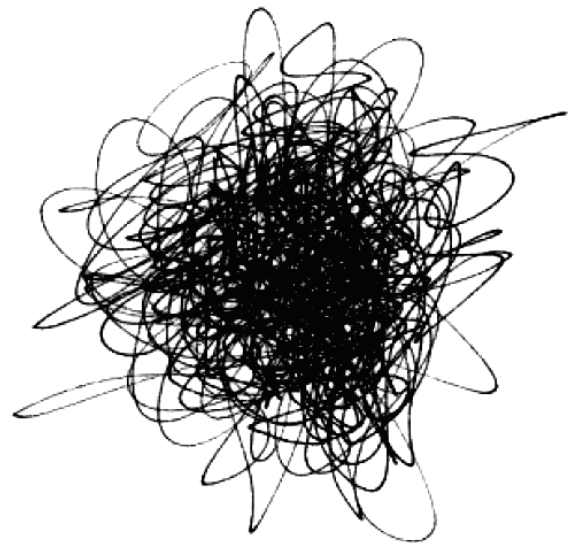














ABOUT THE CREATOR
